GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. Competitors should complete the Entry Form and return it no later than **Friday 15th May 2020**. Entries received after this date will not be accepted.
2. Small fees are necessary to cover costs such as adjudicator expenses and web hosting. Entry Fees are **£1 per competition**. Please make payment by online transfer to our bank account, using your family name as a reference.

3. All written, spoken, and sung material must be in the Scottish Gaelic language, and should reflect Gaelic culture and tradition. Instrumental music should be of Gaelic origin.
4. All competitions will be judged and graded on overall presentation by the adjudicator(s). Only the first three places in each competition will be identified, but all competitors will receive an adjudication. The adjudicators' decision is final.
5. In **Competition E03** groups of 2 or more must perform one accompanied Gaelic song (or set of puirt-a-beul) not exceeding 6 minutes' duration. Each performer may only enter in one group. **No individual adjudications will be given.**
6. In **Competitions E06, E07, E08, E09**, please submit up to three photographs of the piece of art.
7. **Competitions J20, J21, J22, J23 & S01** will take place over the phone or VOIP, such as Zoom. Please note that during these competitions, under 18s must be accompanied by an adult parent or carer who must be able to view the screen at all times. Competitors must use an adult (e.g. parent's) email account or phone number to participate. Any "live" competitions will involve a chairperson along with an adjudicator.
8. In **Competitions J20, J21 & J22**, the competitor may choose from Pets, Hobbies, or Holidays.
9. In **Competitions J23 & S01**, the competitor may choose from Favourite Writer, Film, or Place. Entries from adult learners are encouraged in **Competition S01**.
10. We require consent to be able to display literary and media entries online, by reproducing them on our website or on a social media platform. We also require consent to read literary entries aloud as part of a recorded adjudication. Consent includes naming the competitor. Please ensure you have indicated if consent is given on the entry form, and contact us by email with specific requests.
